How Do I Recycle Curbside?

- 1** Use clear plastic bags provided by the City of Charleston or a recycling bin.* Bags must be clear to see recyclables.
- 2** Place all of your recyclables in the clear plastic bag or bin. There is no need to separate your items by material type.
- 3** On your collection day, place recycling on the curb with your waste.
